PERC Comments on EFG Response
on the minutes of the Raw Materials Supply Group Plenary Meeting 12th November 2012

PERC fully endorses the comments by EFG. Additionally we wish to note that apart from its role in setting standards for public reporting of mineral resources and reserves, and its active participation as a CRIRSCO member in the development of the UN Framework Classification, PERC has two other roles:

- (1) it has a remit to provide training and guidance to minerals companies in Europe, in their reporting of exploration results, mineral resources and mineral reserves, using not only PERC but any other of the CRIRSCO-aligned reporting standards, and
- (2) it is available for participation in national or Europe-wide raw materials studies with the role of assisting in definition, harmonisation, and monitoring of data standards using CRIRSCO and UNFC as appropriate.

PERC would be pleased to provide such services to the Commission or any Member States as well as to participate in developing materials, standards, and reporting procedures suitable for use by public authorities.
