

My dad pulled in outside our house (No 83) at 8.30 this morning and inadvertently created a single lane pinch point with the recycling bin lorry. The right of way was unclear and a queue of about 6 northbound vehicles formed in less than 10 seconds.

I reckon if we could get a couple of those single lane chicanes with priority to southbound traffic it may become such a pain in the neck for drivers that they go back to the A6.

Another suggestion to add to the excellent survey document to create two give way points at Shortlands and Tor Rise and give right of way to the minor roads to ensure traffic has to stop at either side of the schools. I can't remember who to credit for this idea but it isn't mine – but I think it is a good one and can be applied to other side roads.
